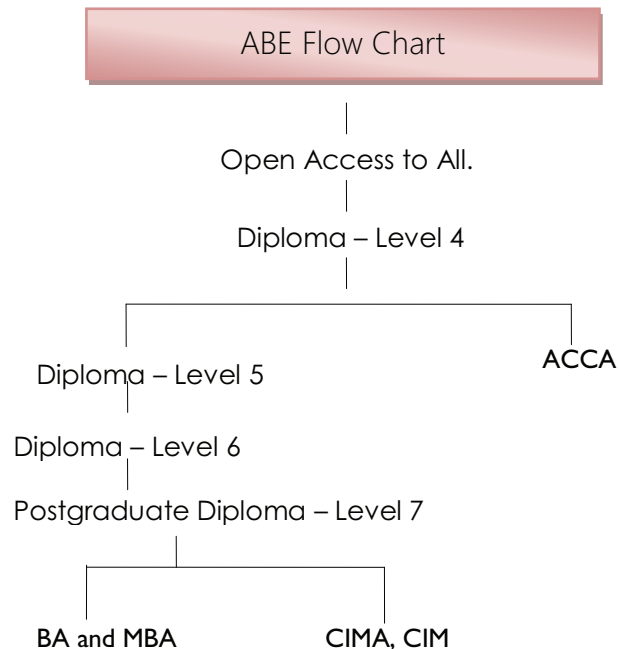
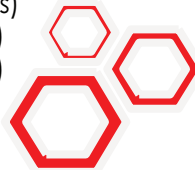
The Business Management programme (BM) offered by ABE is accredited by QCF. The qualification can be used to gain entrance to a University degree. ABE offers the following streams:

1. Business Management
2. Financial Management
3. Management of Information Systems
4. Human Resource Management
5. Travel, Tourism and Hospitality Management
6. Marketing Management

The ABE course is divided into the following levels:

Diploma Level 4

Admission requirements

- a) Open access. Candidates of all educational backgrounds are welcome.
- b) However, it is in the interest of candidates that they have attained Level 2 qualifications (GCSE standard) in Mathematics and English Language, or can demonstrate competence through obtaining an alternative qualification of similar standard.

Diploma – Level 4 – Year one of a degree

1. Introduction to Business
2. Introduction to Quantitative Methods
3. Introduction to Accounting (BM)
4. Introduction to Business Communication
5. Accounting for Financial Managers (FM)



Diploma Level 5

Equivalent to Foundation Degree

Admission requirements

- a) Holders of an ABE Certificate/Diploma Level 4
- b) Two level 3 passes ('A' level standard) Completed
- c) Candidates who, although not holding a formal entry qualification, have been in appropriate employment for at least two years. Signed reference letter required from employer.

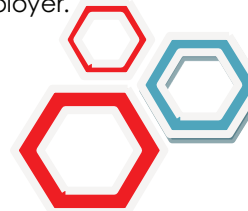
COURSE STRUCTURE

5. Marketing Policy, Planning and Communication
6. Human Resource Management

2. Managerial Accounting (BM / FM)
3. Economics for Business (BM)
4. Systems Mgt & Internal Financial Controls (FM)
5. Managing the Customer Relationship (BM)
6. Entrepreneurship and Business Development (BM)



Diploma Level 6

Equivalent to Bachelor Degree

Admission requirements

- a) ABE NQF Diploma or ABE QCF Level 5 Diploma
- b) A UK Degree or Overseas equivalent, or BTEC HND in business management or related studies
- c) Other level 5 qualifications from another Internationally recognised awarding body or approved Overseas Institutes of Higher Education

COURSE STRUCTURE

The **three compulsory** subjects are:

1. Corporate Strategy and Planning
2. Managing in Organisations
3. International Business – Case Study

Plus two from the following options:

1. Corporate Finance (BM / FM)
2. Project Management
3. Strategic Human Resource Management (BM)
4. Strategic Marketing Management (BM)
5. International Business Finance and Planning (FM)

Postgraduate Diploma Level 7

Equivalent to Postgraduate Degree

Admission requirements

- a) ABE NQF Advanced Diploma or ABE QCF Level 6 Diploma/Graduate Diploma
- b) An honours degree in a related subject awarded by a recognised UK or overseas university
- c) A level 6 qualification from another internationally recognised awarding organisation
- d) Five years senior management experience. A signed reference letter from employers must accompany all such applications.

COURSE STRUCTURE

The **five compulsory** subjects include one exam and four assignments:

1. Strategic Business Management and Planning- EXAM
2. Leadership, Change and People Performance
3. Research Methods and their Application to Marketing
4. Corporate Strategy, Governance and Ethics in the Global Environment
5. Management of Financial Resources and Performance
